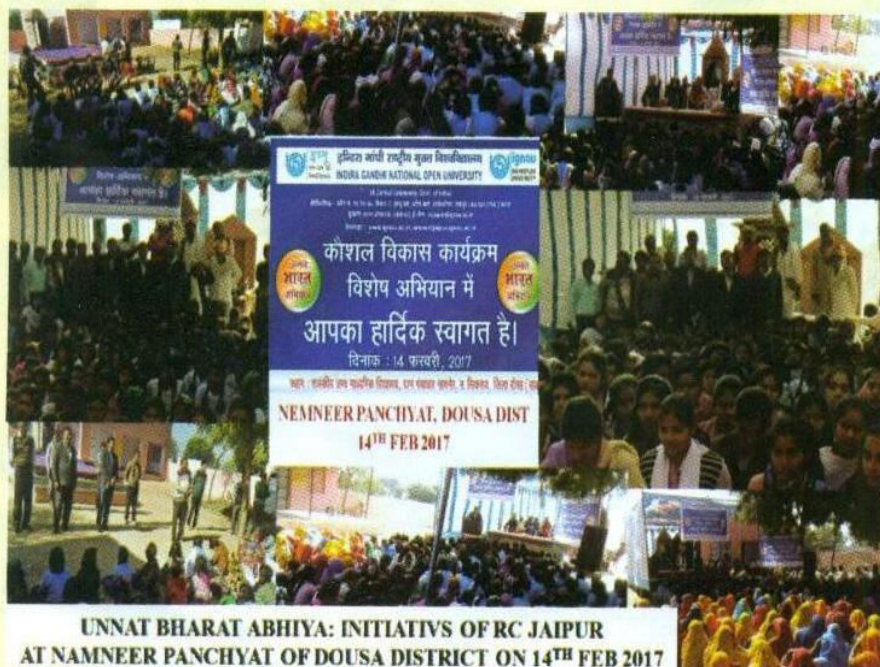


# UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN

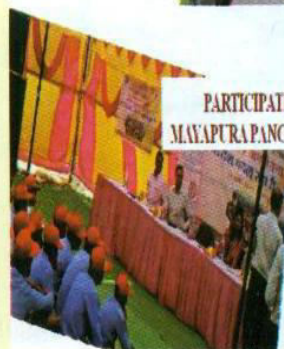
**POSTER COMPETITION AT MEERA MARG SANSKRIT SCHOOL ON 23<sup>RD</sup> MARCH 2017**

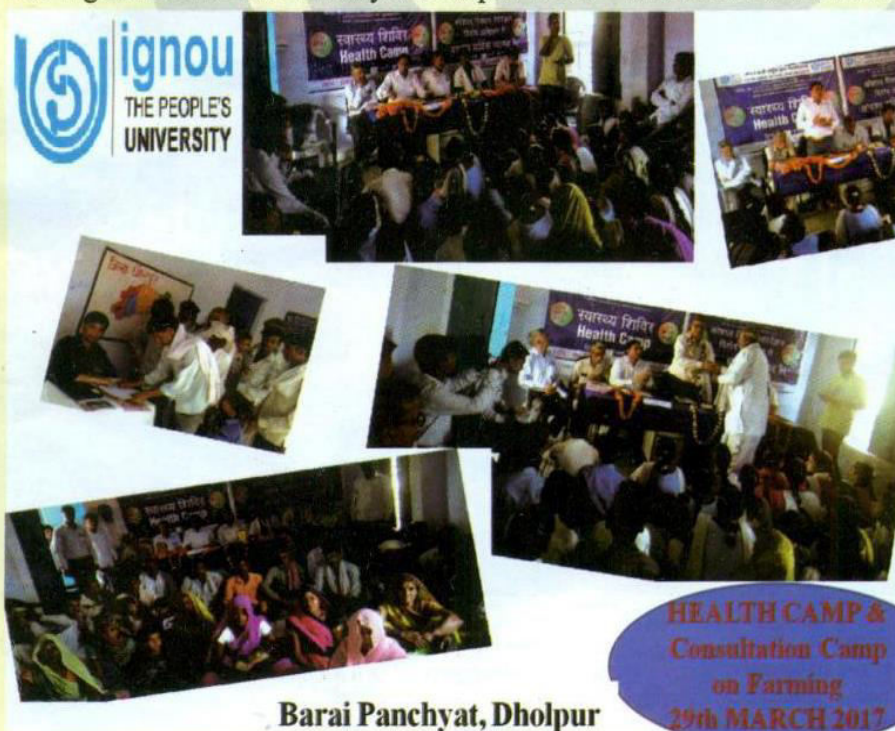
